

To whom this may concern:

Per the Dodd-Frank Act, Section 1502, Non-Ferrous Extrusions does not purchase, consume or use conflict minerals in our production process nor do we incorporate any coatings or components that might contain 3TG minerals (tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold). At no point in our long history have we ever sourced minerals or products from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or any of its neighboring countries.

Furthermore, aluminum is not one of the designated conflict minerals. Our production process' only consume 6XXX series aluminum alloys which fall well within the guidelines recognized by the Aluminum Association.

Finally, Non-Ferrous Extrusions is a privately held company and does not file reports with the SEC; therefore, our aluminum extrusions and other products are considered "out of scope for the purposes of the SEC's Conflict Minerals Rule compliance".

Non-Ferrous Extrusions is fully committed to responsible sourcing practices, and we work diligently with our suppliers to ensure compliance with all of our products.
