

To Whom It May Concern,

Non-Ferrous Extrusions specializes in the production of high-quality, custom aluminum extruded profiles at our manufacturing facilities in Caldwell and Houston, Texas. Each profile is precisely manufactured to customer specifications using aluminum billet sourced from both domestic and international suppliers.

All aluminum billets used in our operations are procured from reputable primary smelters and secondary remelt cast houses. Our international suppliers provide 100% prime aluminum billet, containing no pre- or post-consumer scrap. In contrast, our domestic U.S. supplier of secondary billet reported content in 2024 consisting of approximately 57% pre-consumer scrap and 16% post-consumer scrap. The supplier anticipates maintaining similar recycled content levels for the 2025 calendar year.

Per ISO 14021:2016, both pre-consumer and post-consumer scrap are classified as "recycled content." Definitions are provided below for clarity:

- **Pre-consumer scrap**: Material diverted from the waste stream during a manufacturing process. This excludes rework, regrind, or scrap generated and reused within the same process.
- **Post-consumer scrap**: Material generated by households or commercial, industrial, and institutional facilities in their role as end-users, which can no longer be used for its intended purpose. This also includes returns from the distribution chain.

By sourcing our U.S.-made secondary billet from a well-established domestic supplier with robust recycling practices, we are able to ensure product consistency while supporting environmentally responsible manufacturing.

For projects requiring LEED certification, we recommend specifying U.S.-made secondary billet when placing your extrusion order. This makes it easier to meet project documentation and sustainability requirements.
